Things to know about the Agriculture Camp:



Transportation:

Nicodemus Lodging – Bates Farm (Boys) and Petrie Cabin (Girls).

Check-in is Monday, June 26, 10 am, Kramer Hall lobby!

You are allowed **one bag and NO large suitcases** or athletic bags (think of an airline carry-on bag when figuring out what size).

No video or phone games are allowed. You may bring a cell phone, but it will be turned in to your counselor daily from 8 am – 8 pm. Your counselor will have a phone if there is an emergency.

Items you may bring:

- Swimsuit (modest)
- Closed-toed tennis shoes, **NO FLIP-FLOPS (OK Showers)!**
- No short shorts (girls use fingertip rule); A pair of Jeans
- Two T-shirts (one long sleeve for the fields)
- Toiletries – toothbrush and paste, soap, lotions, sunscreen, hair care products, and towel set (if you have a sibling attending, bring one set of everything to share except a toothbrush).
- Light jacket/sweater/sweatshirt, socks, underclothes, and pajamas.
- Your medication, if you take any... will need to be turned over to Dr. Counts if you are 12 and under.

Things you must have at check-in:

Proof of insurance, copy of Shot records, horseback riding, photo/consent forms, medical and photo waivers, and liability waivers. Send in early if you can!

We provide everything: Transportation, entry fees, all meals, snacks, water, drinks, camp T-shirt, bug spray, etc. **We do not encourage you to send money with your camper, because we will NOT be held responsible for replacing** lost or stolen cash **or** unauthorized items.

All administration, counselors, and adult leaders are CPR/First Aid certified, while in Manhattan, emergencies will be taken to Mercy Regional and Nicodemus, Graham County Hospital.
